HISTORY OF CELT MINI-GRANTS

Grant Program Initiated in 2004

- 1st grade Owl presentation to each classroom by Chewonki (2006-present). \$700-\$918.
- 2nd grade Rainforest/Biome presentation to each classroom by Chewonki (2006-present). \$700-\$918.
- Adopt a Saw-Whet Owl from Audubon by Mrs. Abbott's 1st grade class. \$25
- 1st grade weekly subscription to Kids National Geographic. \$500
- Awarded \$1000 to the high school environmental club for a composting system for the cafeteria. Our grant was combined with funds awarded from CEEF and the club's fundraising dollars (total project cost \$3000).
- Middle School Art Program (\$2,500): Middle School Art project for grades 5-8, combining landscape painting, and environmental writing on CELT property. Photos to be displayed at Thomas Memorial Library. Photos sold at CELT Paint for Preservation.
- Awarded \$300 for grow lights for seedlings for the three Pond Cove classrooms involved with the raised garden beds
- Middle School stipend for the new Environmental Club advisor (\$240). The school budget paid the other half of the stipend expense
- Plant ID Project (\$1500): Joanne Bearor completed her 7th grade identification book project with the kids, identifying plant material around the CELT office property. As 8th graders, they continued this project.
- Gardening materials for Raised Vegetable Garden Beds. \$100/year (2009-2013).
- Middle School Garden Club: Adam Killip's grant to reestablish the Middle School raised garden vegetable beds (\$1000)! He also applied to CEMS for \$500 to purchase additional supplies for the beds
- Grant approved to purchase 20 frames (\$400) for MS photo exhibit. Framed art will be permanently displayed in the MS after the spring TML exhibit.
- Note: Several books, taxidermy mounts and other materials have also been funded by CELT for the ERC.
