



Farms, Forests and the Sea: Capturing Natural Cape **2019 CELT Photo Contest**

The Cape Elizabeth Land Trust (CELT) is pleased to invite area residents to submit up to 5 images for the 2019 CELT Photo Contest. Three winning photographs will be selected by our judges who are accomplished local photographers. Winners will be notified via e-mail and announced on our website by mid-November. All submissions will be posted on the CELT website for the duration of the contest. **Deadline for submissions is November 15, 2019.**

Guidelines

- Preference will be given to photographs that represent the natural beauty of CELT properties, as well as Cape Elizabeth farmland and wildlife. Photographs of people enjoying CELT property are especially encouraged. (Photographs of minors will require a release signed by parent or guardian.)
- Photographs that capture close-ups of wildlife or nature in Cape Elizabeth, but not on CELT property, will be considered if the surrounding property is not identifiable.
- Contestants can be residents of any town.
- Contestants may submit up to five digital images with a minimum size of 7 megabytes (a minimum of 1600 pixels on the longest side at 300 dpi) in jpeg format.
- Please include the location of each image, your phone number and mailing address with your submission. Additional details of the story around taking the picture are welcome!

- All entrants agree to allow CELT to use their photographs in perpetuity on its website and in the newsletter, social media or other digital and printed marketing or fundraising materials.

Submission and Deadline

Prizes

First, Second and Third Place winners will receive photo notecards of their image (100, 75, and 50 cards with envelopes, respectively) and a CELT water bottle to carry on your photography trips. Winners will also be publicized in press releases and on CELT's website, newsletter and social media outlets.
